1. Call Town Board Meeting to Order

e) Marking Driveway Entrances

Discussion ensued on improvements to the two entrances to town hall such as signage and lighting. There was a consensus improvements should be considered in the terms of public safety.

8. Public Comments

Inquiry was made on any updates to RR crossings and road closures. Discussion ensued. An option was discussed on closing Cemetery Road entirely and Viaduct Road for foot-traffic only. More updates expected in the near future.

Inquiry was made on the repair or replacement of broken/damaged trash can. The Town Clerk provided the customer service number to the vendor Waste Management along with instructions on how to get a replacement can.

Discussion ensued on the short-term rental ordinance. Referral will be made to the Town Chairman.

Ms. Jillian Saiberlich from Envision Greater Fond du Lac delivered a business presentation to the town board and those in attendance.
